The Herd are looking for creative, enthusiastic student volunteers with an interest in **making theatre with children** to join us on our **One Day Play Programme**.



WHAT IS ONE DAY PLAY?

One Day Play is a unique experience for primary schools in Hull - a chance for Key Stage 2 children to experience the professional theatre-making process in just one day. Primary School classes are invited into a professional theatre setting and given the opportunity to explore every element of the theatre from writing to performance, from design to stage management. Filled with games, music, tactile props and the brilliance of children's imaginations, One Day Play is a fun-filled, high quality introduction to the exciting and empowering world of theatre.

WHAT WILL I DO AS A VOLUNTEER?

Support the Herd's theatre facilitators in the delivery of the day. You'll join in with all activities, modelling behaviour and helping participants through exercises. You'll work with smaller break out groups and you'll help the facilitators turn the children's ideas into a brand new play.

WHAT EXPERIENCE DO I NEED?

None. We're just looking for people with an interest in drama and a genuine enthusiasm for working with children. Whether you're in your first year of a drama course at college or completing a degree this year, we'd love to speak to you.

WILL THERE BE ANY TRAINING?

Volunteers will receive a day of training with The Herd in which you will learn approaches to drama facilitation, from games to empowering participants to working with children with additional needs. Volunteering on One Day Play will give you real life professional experience of making theatre with children with critically acclaimed local theatre company, The Herd.

PROJECT DATES

Training will take place on **Friday 17th May 2024 2pm - 3.30pm** and we'll be asking all volunteers to attend this training. Sessions will then run at different locations in Hull including Hull University and Hull Truck Theatre.

There will be 20 days of delivery this academic year from **Monday 3rd June - Friday 28th June.**

Usually volunteers help with 1 or 2 days, but you can support with more session if you'd like to.

The Herd are currently under commission for a large scale family project with The Southbank Centre.
